Guylaine Bernier worked for almost 35 years for Quebec Hydro as Head of the Human Resource Planning and Management Development Department. In 2000, she left the position to launch her own management consulting company, Bernier Montminy Inc. where she remains as President today.

Guylaine is the President of Canadian Sport Centre Montreal (CNMM) and is currently on the Board of Directors of the 2013 Canada Games Host Society in Sherbrooke.

Not only a successful business woman, Guylaine is also an accomplished rower. She has attained success as an athlete, coach, official, administrator and regatta organizer. Highlights of her elite athletic career include competing at the 1975 World Rowing Championships and the 1976 Olympic Games in Montreal.

She was member of the Rowing Canada Aviron Board and was President and now Honorary member of the Board of the Quebec Rowing Association. Guylaine also created a Fund which provides financial support for the continued development of rowing in Québec with the profits of close to \$200,000 made from organizing an international regatta that she led.

She is currently an international rowing umpire and after 16 years recently completed her mandate as member of the International Rowing Federation (FISA) Umpiring Commission.

Along with being involved in many Olympic Games, Guylaine has been involved in many firsts as she was the President of the Jury for the 1st Rowing Regatta at the Paralympic Games in Beijing and the 1st Youth Olympic Games Regatta as well in Singapore.

Guylaine was inducted into the Quebec Sports Hall of Fame in 1996 and she has received various awards for her work as an official and event organizer. The City of Montreal chose Guylaine as their final torchbearer during the Vancouver 2010 Olympic Torch Relay.
