Tom has always been active in the sport community as a volunteer, coach, participant and administrator and continues to enjoy his time on the golf course, surfing, paddle boarding, and snowboarding. He has been promoting an active lifestyle in his role as Editor of the Fusion magazine for the past 11 years and continues to focus on being involved in initiatives that promote a healthier and more active lifestyle.
