

# **Sue Hylland**

## **President and CEO, Canada Games Council**

Sue Hylland is President and CEO of the Canada Games Council. She joined the Council in late May 2002 after having been the Executive Director of the Canadian Association for the Advancement of Women and Sport and Physical Activity (CAAWS) for one and a half years. Prior to this, Ms. Hylland spent nearly 18 years with the Canadian Olympic Committee (COC) in the Sport Technical and Games areas, which included participation in ten Olympic and Pan Am Games. She was the lead staff of Canada's operations at the Nagano 1998 and Sydney 2000 Olympic Games.

Ms. Hylland was named to the All-Canadian Women's Basketball Team in her graduating year at Bishop's University and was co-captain of the gold medal Quebec Women's basketball team in the 1979 Canada Winter Games in Brandon, Manitoba.

She was born and raised in Montreal and now resides in Ottawa with her husband and three children. She continues to be active in sport in her community as participant, coach and volunteer.
