



2015 Canada Winter Games Sport Selection

The Canada Games Council has initiated its 2015 Sport Selection Process. All National Sport Organizations who do not have sports or disciplines on the 2013 Canada Summer Games Program, and all sports or disciplines that can take place in a winter Games environment, have been invited to complete a questionnaire for consideration for the 2015 sport program. Unfortunately, the Federal-Provincial/Territorial funding framework of the Canada Games does not allow space for all interested sports or disciplines to be included in each Canada Games program. Therefore, the Canada Games Council's Sport Committee has created an ethical, transparent, and objective sport selection process, based on the values and objectives of the Canada Games, to consider all interested sports or disciplines that wish to be included in the program.

Core sports and disciplines named to the winter program automatically due to their popularity in Canada, for both men and women, include: Alpine Skiing, Badminton, Curling, Figure Skating, Ice Hockey, Short and Long Track Speed Skating. Twenty-one other sports and disciplines will be considered for the 2015 Canada Winter Games in the province of British Columbia. The list of sports will be released before the launch of the bid process for the 2015 Canada Winter Games in June, 2009.
