*The athletics team complement permits up to 33 men and up to 33 women, with the total number of *athletes* not to exceed 61. Five (5) of the team positions are reserved exclusively for wheelchair track athletes. At minimum, two (2) of the wheelchair track athletes must be female, and two (2) of the wheelchair track athletes must be male. Two (2) positions, 1 for males and 1 for females, are reserved for AWAD field events. Additionally, two (2) of the male team positions are reserved exclusively for Special Olympics athletes and two (2) of the female team positions are reserved exclusively for Special Olympics athletes.

**The swimming team complement includes 2 male and 2 female positions reserved exclusively for athletes with a physical disability. The figures also include 2 male and 2 female positions reserved exclusively for Special Olympic Canada registered swimmers. If bringing Special Olympics athletes, teams may designate one (1) coach for their Special Olympians.
