

# OUR FUNDING PARTNERS

## The Government of Canada

The Government of Canada contributes approximately \$5 million per year to the Canada Games. The federal government also covers the out-of-province transportation of athletes, coaches, and officials.

A Canada Games host society receives \$2 million in capital funding, and \$3.8 million (Summer Games) or \$3 million (Winter Games) of operating support according to a financial framework established for the Games.

## The Provincial and Territorial Governments

The athletes who compete at the Canada Games are the product of sport programs operated by the provincial and territorial sport organizations with funding from the provincial and territorial governments. The provincial and territorial governments are also responsible for the training and preparation of their teams competing in the Games.

In addition, a host society will receive from the host provincial or territorial government \$2 million in capital funding and \$1.1 million (Summer Games) or \$.9 million (Winter Games) in operating support. Travel of athletes within the host province and territory is also the responsibility of the host provincial or territorial government.

## The Host Municipal Government

The host municipal government contributes \$2 million in capital support. Over the course of the 4+ years of planning and preparation, host municipal governments also provide other resources, both human and financial, to host societies.

## Sponsors and other partners

The Canada Games continue to grow bigger and better due to the commitment of their sponsors and partners. In collaboration with the Canada Games Council, a host society develops strategies for generating revenue (cash and in-kind) from the corporate sector and Friends of the Games. These amounts can account for up to 40-50% of the Games' operating budget.
